

Notice from the Election Committee

Nominations papers are due on March 8, 2017.

The Election Committee will accept Nomination papers beginning at 3 PM until the end of the Membership meeting or 6 PM.

Make certain that the person signing the nomination papers is a member in good standing of the Boston Teachers' Union!

Have the BTU member complete each column according to the following guidelines:

- PRINT name legibly!
- Sign name as legibly as possible.
- Enter home address. This address must match the one on file in the BTU office.
- Enter work location.
- Enter work position – Teacher (includes School Nurse), Para (includes Library, 1 to 1, Instructional, Surround Care, Health & CFC, ASL Interpreters), Sub (nurse, per diem, long-term or cluster), Special Program Assignment (Psych, SESS, OT, PT, etc.) or Retiree

Any information entered on this nomination paper that is incorrect or illegible could jeopardize the placement of this candidate on the 2017 ballot!

Candidates are urged to obtain at least twice the number of signatures required for any particular position on the ballot.

Minimum Number of Required Signatures:

- Full-time Officer – 100 (President, Executive Vice President, Secretary Treasurer, Political Action Director, Field Representatives)
- Executive Board – 50 (12 Positions)
- Para Council – 25 (15 positions)
- Delegate to Any Affiliated body – 25 (Number of Positions Vary)

If you are signing nomination papers, you may not sign more papers than the number of positions available for that particular position. (For example, one for president, twelve for E-Board)

Dates of Election Committee Meetings - members welcome to attend - time will be allowed for questions from non-committee members. Meetings are at 5 pm at the BTU.
