Additionally, there will be a video station for people to record their memories of involvement with the BTU and working in the BPS. Everything will be included in a digital open access archive.

The event is part of BTU's new partnership with the University Archive & Special Collections Department in the Healey Library at UMass Boston Archives. We will be donating copies of all our *Boston Union Teacher* newspapers, copies of our contracts and other documents of historic value to the UMass Boston Archives where they will be preserved and available to all for research purposes.
