Through contract negotiations, the Boston Teachers Union is fighting for:



- Guaranteed funding for the arts, athletics, libraries, STEM, and world languages in every school
- Sustained investments in long overdue new constructions and renovations



- Enough educators and specialized staff to meet the individualized and special needs of all students
- An end to a single teacher having to do the job of two (or more!) teachers



- Nationally recommended ratios of students to school counselors (1:250), students to school psychologists (1:500) and additional social workers
- More Community Hub Schools that provide before and after-school care, family engagement, and integrated systems of support



- A living wage for educators that allows them to stay in the communities they serve
- One job should be enough for our lowest paid members
- An end to a two-tier system where teachers at certain schools make less
